DENVER—Putting their focus on community issues into action, young professionals in the Denver Metro Chamber Leadership Foundation's Impact Denver class will help 10 organizations with community impact projects.

<u>Impact Denver</u> is one of the Leadership Foundation's six programs aimed at building strong community-minded leaders. Participants get an introduction to civic and business issues, learn from local leaders and experts and volunteer in the community over six months.
